

■ **Implementation of 2010 Peak Season Surcharge (PSS)  
Trans-Pacific Trade – Eastbound**

June 21, 2010

Dear Customer,

We would like to inform you that Hapag-Lloyd will increase its Peak Season Surcharge, originally implemented June 28, on all dry, reefer, flat rack and open top containers in the trade from East Asia and Indian Sub-Continent to Canada and USA as follows:

- Effective Date of Increase: July 27, 2010 (Date of cargo receipt at origin)
- Scope: East Asia and Indian Sub-Continent (excluding India) to USA and Canada:
  - Quantum to USWC / Group 4 destinations:
    - From:           US\$ 320     to:     US\$ 480/20' Container
    - US\$ 400     to:     US\$ 600/40' Container
    - US\$ 450     to:     US\$ 675/40' High Cube Container
    - US\$ 510     to:     US\$ 756/45' High Cube Container
  - Quantum to USEC / IPI / RIPI destinations:
    - From:           US\$ 320     to:     US\$ 560/20' Container
    - US\$ 400     to:     US\$ 700/40' Container
    - US\$ 450     to:     US\$ 788/40' High Cube Container
    - US\$ 510     to:     US\$ 882/45' High Cube Container
